Welcome to Life Beyond Tourism Network!

This is a brief **Guideline** to help all the new bloggers of our Photoblog to quickly upload their pictures. Firstly however, we inform you that the **Life Beyond Tourism Network** consists on the **No-Profit Portal**, the **Photoblog**, the **Blog**, the **Forum** and the:

Now let's see how you can become an author of the Photoblog:

Enter to the website, and click on the "REGISTER NOW" button as underlined in the following image:

Once you're logged in, you will be able to see the following **Dashboard** from where you will **Upload, Modify and Delete** your future Posts. The functions you will mainly use is called: POST (= Articles made of your photo and your relevant description). **The others will be listed below, for information purposes only.**

ARTICLES (Post)

Regarding this section you will be able to do the following: **Add New** (insert a new article-post and submit it to the administration for approval) , **Tags** (keywords you must enter in association to each article-post) , **Category** (categories available, under which you must file your article-post)

a) How to write an article-post:

- Add the title in space "**TITLE**". And - Write the text in space "**TEXT**".

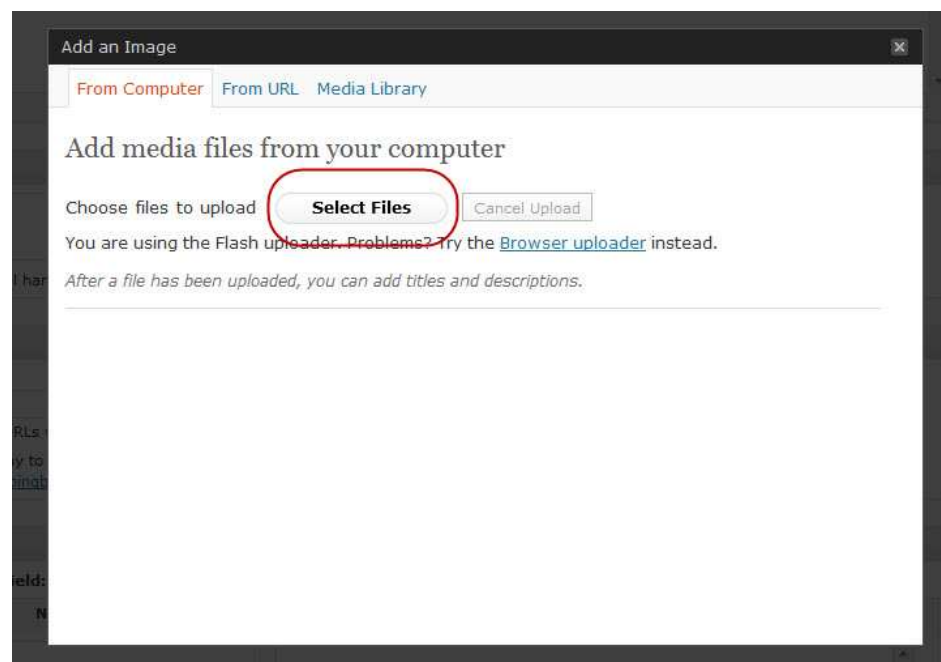
If the you are copying the your photo's descriptionfromanother program such as, for instance, Word (.doc) Adobe Reader(.pdf) you **must** firstly copy and paste the relevant text into the "**NOTE PAD**" to delete characters, tables, or layouts that the site will not display correctly; and consequently copy and paste the text again from NotePad into your account's article-post/Dashboard of the Photoblog.

b) To add the PICTURE inside the article-post:

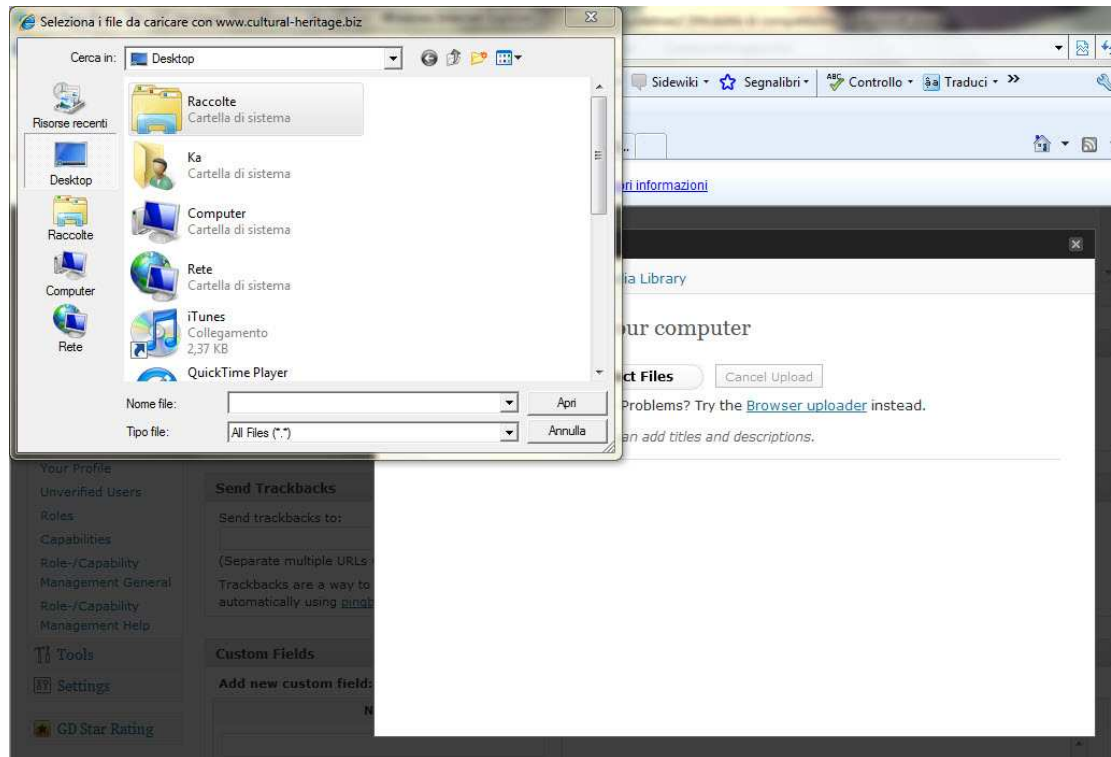


Click on the first **icon** after the word "add media" as shown above. A new window will appear.

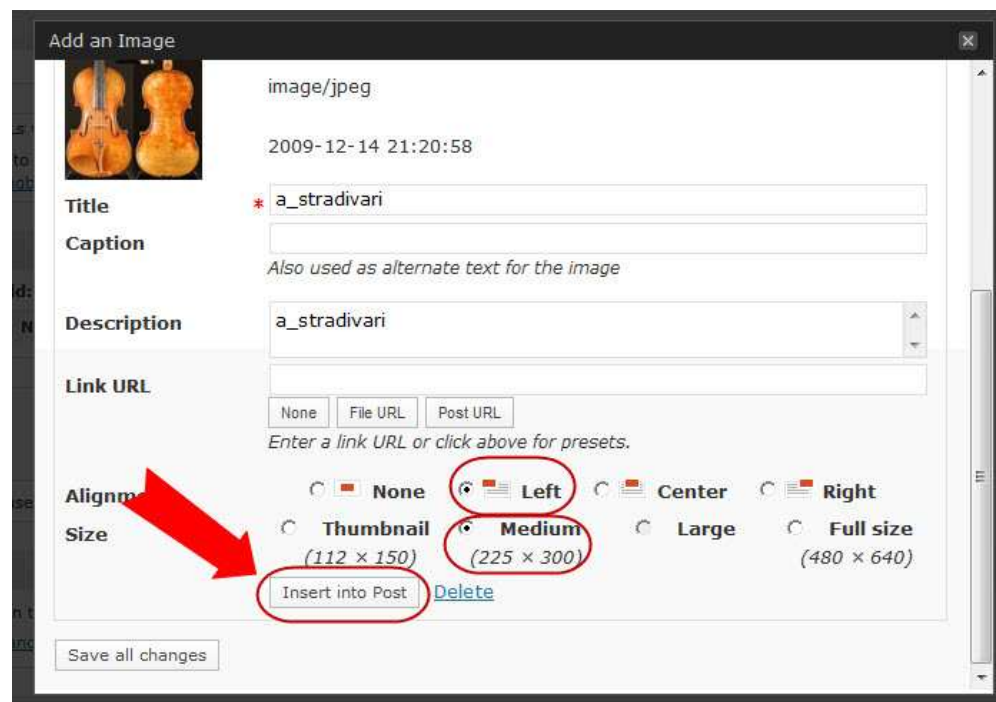
- Click on "**select a file to upload**" as highlighted in a gray rectangle.



- Then select **your image** from your computer folders, and upload the image by following the rules of the software:
Resolution must be **72 dpi** or normal size. Otherwise, the file would not be proportioned. **Maximum size is 2MB.**



Following the options offered by the software, please remember to always edit the image on the left, in medium size. Then click on the **'Insert into the Post'** button – in order to have your images shown into your post/article.



c) How to save an Article: (see image below)

- While you are working on the post, click on **"Save Draft"** (on the right column) from time to time.
- Once you finish your job and you are satisfied with it, click on **"Submit to Review"**. This option will send the article to the administrators of the Photoblog in order for them to moderate it for final approval and publishing.
- If you wish to see how your post/article look like before submission, you can do so by clicking on **"Preview article"** on the right

d) How to Add in the field "categories" the category/field to which the article-post belongs: (see image below)

- On the right end side of the page find the section called "categories".
- First, flag all the categories related to **YOU: your nationality, your age, your group of activities**
- Then, flag all the Categories that you think belongs to the article-post (do not exceed with the number of categories, maximum 5)

e) How to add the Tags/Keywords: (see image below)

Write **the most important words** about the article in the space **"TAGS"** (keywords). The words must be separated by a comma. Once you finish adding your Tags, simply click on **Add**. Do not exceed with the number. Add just 5 tags per article-post.

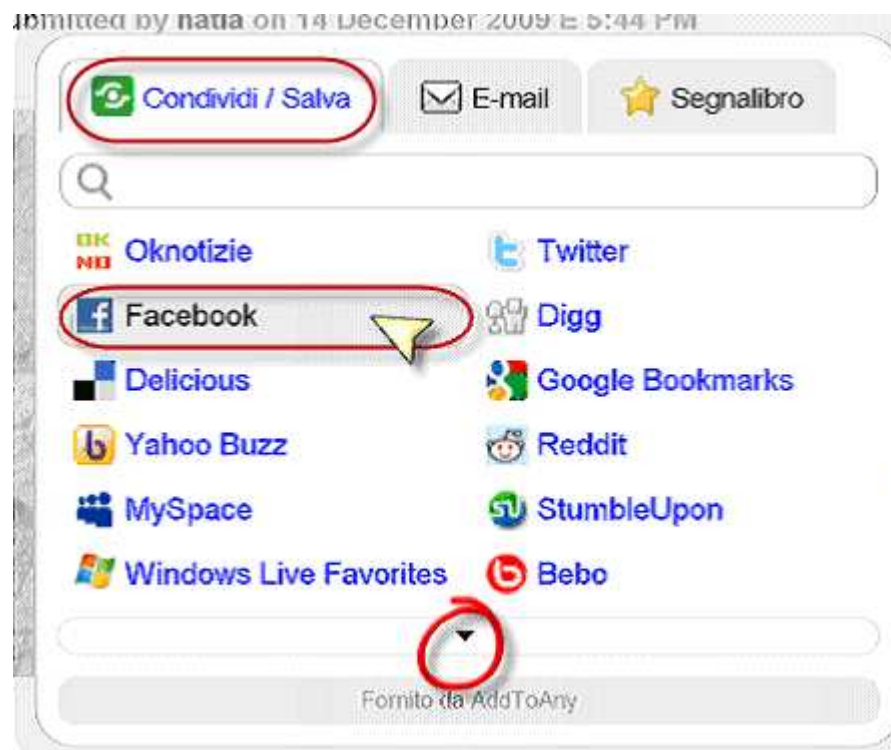
f) How to share an Article-post-photo with your friends and send it to your favorite social network

Below each photograph's article-post, you will find this bar which permits you to share the article-post with your friends and/or to save it in your browser's bookmarks: rest the mouse/pointer on the bar (without double clicking). A window will appear automatically, and will give you three different sharing options. The three different options are subdivided into three different bookmarks: 1. Share and Save on social networks, 2. Send by email, 3. Save on your browser's bookmarks.

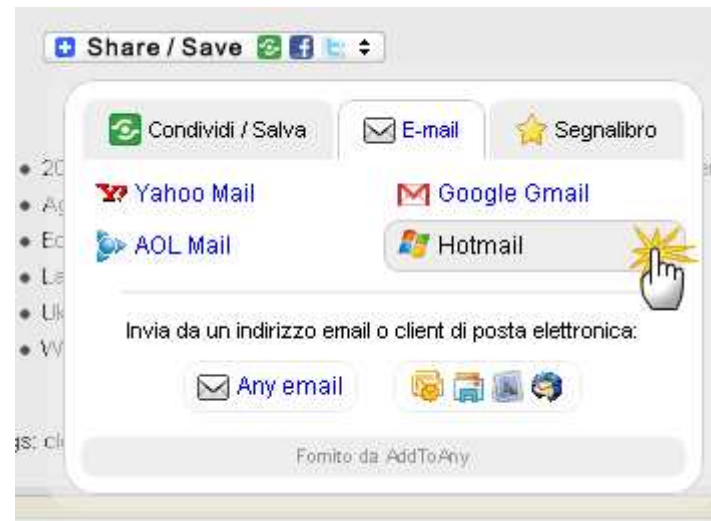
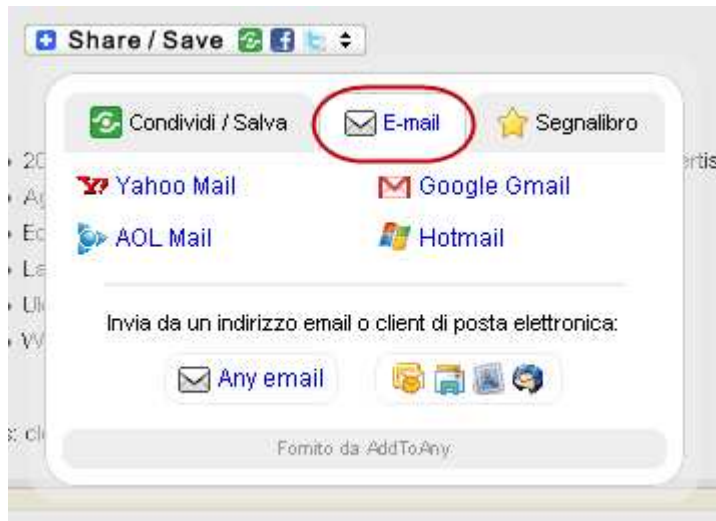

2. Option 2: Send by email

If you would rather like to send the article-post by email to a friend:

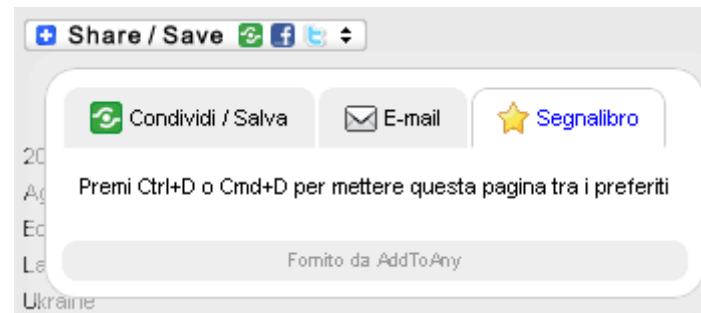
- a. click on the second bookmark ("E-mail") that you find on the Share and Save window



- b. Select your email-service operator
- c. The login page will open and your email provider's login page will be ready

3. Option 3: Save on your browser's bookmarks

If you wish, you can also save your favorite article-post among your browser's bookmarks, by selecting the third bookmark ("Favorite Bookmark" or 'Segnalibro') that you find on the Share and Save window. Please notice that instruction to bookmark a page can differ depending on the browser you are using.
